Student Information and Athletic Participation Sheet

All students desiring acceptance to any of our school programs must follow the admissions guidelines of our Parent/Student Handbook.

Part time students are those taking fewer than four core academic classes, but must take AT LEAST ONE academic on-site course to participate in athletics. (Grades 9 – 12)

Any student enrolled in another high school or college PSEO program may not participate as a parttime student or athlete at FBCS.

The Application process for a part time student is as follows:

- 1. Fill out the application, reference forms, etc. and pay the \$35.00 Application Fee.
- 2. Upon receipt of the application, an interview will be scheduled with the administrator, parents and student (for new students only). Testing may be necessary if the student is taking academic classes with us.
- 3. After the interview (and testing), a determination will be made and communicated by letter or email.
- 4. Part time students who take courses on the campus of FBCS must provide the school with immunization and health records.

Participation in the FBCS Sports Program:

- 1. Must interview with the administrator and be accepted through the application process.
- 2. Must pay the Sports Activity Fee and \$35 Registration fee.
- 3. Must provide the school with a copy of sports physical clearance form & insurance card.
- 4. Must submit a signed copy of the FBCS Partnership Agreement each year.
- 5. Must take AT LEAST ONE on-site academic course. (Grades 9 12)

Any student participating in any school activity must adhere to the Handbook requirements including following the dress code and standards of behavior. Handbooks are available in the school office. Part-time students & student athletes are subject to dismissal for disregard to school rules, policies, and/or behavior that does not represent the standards of FBCS.
